- · With the precision afforded by the imaging and the robotic technology, men treated with this surgery experience a very low rate of irreversible complications, such as incontinence, ejaculatory dysfunction, and erectile dysfunction.
- This course of treatment has been proven to offer years of relief from BPH symptoms.
