Who We Are

Piedmont Columbus Regional dates back to 1836 when the local hospital was a small building on the Chattahoochee River. It is now the region's healthcare leader, offering compassionate care and an unwavering commitment to patients. Piedmont Columbus Regional consists of two primary hospitals, a children's hospital, a cancer center, and over 35 physician practice locations. Piedmont Columbus Regional joined the Piedmont family in March 2018.

Midtown Campus is a 583-bed, acute care hospital and features a regional Level II trauma center, one of only six perinatal centers in the state with a Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and is the only Piedmont facility with a Children's Hospital. It has been home to the Family Medicine Residency Program since 1972. The nationally recognized program, which was the first of its kind in Georgia and one of the first in the Southeast, has graduated over 1,000 family physicians.

Northside Campus is a licensed 100-bed general acute care hospital specializing in orthopedic, spine, bariatrics, gynecology, urology and general surgical services. Northside is proud to be a Comprehensive Bariatrics Center, Blue Cross Blue Shield Bariatrics Center of Excellence and Surgical Quality Partner. The hospital's commitment to delivering outstanding clinical quality is nationally recognized, and Northside prides itself on offering the highest levels of customer service.

Our Mobile Unit offers services and health education programs to meet the needs and improve the health of the Chattahoochee Valley area. The 40-foot vehicle, which serves as a mobile clinic, consists of a waiting area, well-equipped exam rooms and a lab. The Mobile Unit team consists of a registered nurse, social worker, physicians and a pharmacist. Through health screenings, health and wellness education and resources, the Mobile Unit is able to help identify and target health risks. SOURCE (Serving Options Using Resources in Community Environment) serves citizens in five area counties. This program provides in-home health and medical services for the aged and disabled on Medicaid and helps them remain in their homes for as long as possible.

Piedmont Columbus Regional has garnered national acclaim in clinical quality, patient satisfaction, stroke care, oncology and pediatrics. Piedmont Columbus Regional is also the lead agency for Safe Kids Columbus, and a proud partner of Auburn University Athletics.
