Instructions

Please follow the instructions below to access the courses from the 2019 Hot Topics Conference on-line courses on Piedmont University.

- Log in as a student to Piedmont University (either via The Village/Connect or directly at www.piedmontu.org)
 - Employed physicians - Use your Piedmont employee ID and your Piedmont University password (NOT your network access password).
 - Non-employed physicians, use your P# (P and the last 5 digits of your medical license)
 - Non-employed credentialed staff, use your user ID.
 - If you have never logged onto Piedmont University, you will need to use the default password – Wer1pdmt – and then immediately change your password.
 - If you are having problems logging on, please contact onlineeducation@piedmont.org for assistance.
- Go to the Catalog tab, on the ribbon on top of the page. A search box will open. Enter the words “2019 Hot Topics.” The following options will appear:

- Select one of the choices. Each course includes a pre-test, supplemental learning materials, a video of the lecture, a post test, and an evaluation. The estimated time to complete the course is 35 minutes.
- Click on the Enroll button and start the course.
- After viewing the video portion of the course, the post-test will “un-lock.” Click on that link and take the post test. You must pass with a score of 100% (3/3 or 4/4 questions). You have two attempts to pass the post test.
- Complete the course evaluation. When you submit this form, you will be able to print your certificate.
