Piedmont Newnan is currently undergoing a \$65 million South Tower Expansion Project (STEP) that broke ground in October 2022. The expansion will add 80,000 square feet and three floors in phase one, with the intent to continue to build additional floors in future phases, and is the most significant investment Piedmont Healthcare has made in Coweta County since building this hospital on Poplar Road in 2012.
