PGY-1 Pharmacy Residency



Program Description

The Piedmont Atlanta Hospital Post-Graduate Year 1 (PGY1) Pharmacy Residency program builds on the Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and develops clinical pharmacists who will be responsible for medication-related care to patients with a wide range of conditions. After this year, residents will be eligible for board certification and for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

Research Requirement

Residents are required to:

- Design, develop and complete a research project, which must be reviewed and approved by the Residency Research Committee & RPD
- Present their projects at the Southeastern Residency Conference (SERC) or another meeting approved by the RPD and complete a publishable manuscript.

Additional Activities

Residents are also required to perform the following activities

- Participation in P&T Committee meetings
- Complete a Medication Use Evaluation
- Assist in the education of Pharm. D students
- Participate in the Atlanta Pharmacy Residency Information Exchange (APRIE)
- Fulfill staffing requirements
- Provide coverage in Pharmacy every third weekend
- Provide coverage for Pharmacy Clinical Services for three holidays
- Participate in various hospital committees/work groups that have pharmacy involvement/input

Stipend and Benefits

- Annual stipend \$47,500
- Ten days of paid time off
- Ten days of professional leave
- Travel allowance for ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting and SERC
- Health, vision, and dental insurance
- Life insurance

Qualifications

- Graduate of ACPE-accredited Colleges of Pharmacy with a Doctor of Pharmacy degree
- Applicants must be licensed in the State of Georgia within 90 days of starting the residency
- Applicants must be eligible to work in the United States

Qualified applicants will be contacted to schedule an onsite interview

Applications

- Applicants must be registered with the National Matching Service and the PhORCAS system. Application packets must include:
 - Official College Transcripts
 - Letter of intent
 - Curriculum vitae
 - At least 3 letters of reference
