




Data Collection Round 2 (2017)

- Police reviewed every police incident report recorded in 2017 (18,042 reports)
- Police recorded 1325 interactions with potential mental health consumers (7%)
- Those interactions were with 636 individuals





Mental Health First Aid

- Mental Health First Aid/ Mental Health First Aid for Public Safety
 - Developed in Australia in 2006
 - Aims to teach the public how to respond to a mental health emergency or offer support to someone who appears to be in a mental health crisis
 - 8 hours of instruction and activities
 - Gives the public and action plan for each diagnoses
 - Open to anyone



Mental Health First Aid

- Assess for risk of suicide or harm
- Listen non-judgementally
- Give reassurance and Information
- Encourage appropriate professional help
- Encourage self-help and other support strategies



Crisis Intervention Training



- 40 hour class
 - Schizophrenia
 - Mood disorders
 - Understanding Suicide
 - Addictive diseases
 - Personality Disorders
 - Developmental Disabilities
 - PTSD

- Co-Occurring Disorders
- Alzheimer's
- Child & Adolescent Intervention
- Site Visits
- De-Escalation Techniques
- Consumer Perspective
- Family Perspective
- Officer Self Care



Trauma -Informed Training

- 4 hour training
- Develop Understanding
- Increase overall awareness
- Recognize signs of trauma
- Learn how to respond to symptoms of trauma
- Increase Safety
- Promote recovery of those in your care
- Reduce recidivism rates

- •5-6 hours
- Most common diagnoses signs and symptoms
- Suicide assessment
- Trauma informed care
- De-escalation techniques and role play
- Real scenarios used as teaching tools
- Tailored to the needs of the organization

- 24 hour block of instruction
- Developed specifically for Athens-Clarke County
- Local resources are discussed
- Training on Developmental Disabilities
- Videos, Videos, Videos
