



The Facility


Piedmont Athens Regional Medical Center is a 360-bed nonprofit hospital and regional referral center serving a 17-county service area in Athens and Northeast Georgia. We offer a Level 2 Trauma Center and Level 3 Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), urgent care centers and an extensive network of respected physicians, surgeons and specialists.

Not only has Piedmont Athens Regional been chosen as the first Georgia affiliate for Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, but it is also the official healthcare provider for the University of Georgia Athletic Association. Piedmont Athens Regional has been recognized among the top 100 hospitals in the nation preferred by women and on the U.S. News and World Report's Best Hospitals list.

Department of Pharmacy

The Department of Pharmacy employs 85 staff including 45 pharmacists. The pharmacy operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. In addition to staffing our central pharmacy, pharmacists are decentralized to our operating room satellite and most patient care units, where they participate in multidisciplinary rounds. They also practice in specialized areas including:

- adult ICU
- emergency medicine
- infectious disease
- inpatient and outpatient anticoagulation management and ambulatory care.

Qualifications

- Graduate of ACPE-accredited Colleges of Pharmacy with a Doctor of Pharmacy degree
- Applicants must be licensed in the State of Georgia within 90 days of starting the residency
- Applicants must be eligible to work in the United States

Applications

The Piedmont Athens Regional program uses the National Matching Service and the PhORCAS system. Application packets must include:

- Official College Transcripts
- Letter of intent
- Curriculum vitae
- At least 3 letters of reference. *A minimum of two references must be from individuals able to speak to clinical problem solving in direct patient care experiences.*

Program Purpose

The purpose of the 12-month PGY1 program is to build on Doctor of Pharmacy education and to prepare pharmacists to practice, as highly qualified independent practitioners who can provide patient care in a variety of environments, be eligible for board certification and to excel in postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

Upon completion, the resident is expected to:

- Cultivate leadership skills
- Develop effective communication skills
- Maintain independent learning skills
- Possess a professional ethic
- Provide effective drug education to patients, providers and students
- Provide pharmaceutical care in multiple settings
- Take responsibility for self-evaluation of work
- Understand and participate in the drug distribution system
