



MARY ANN PEASE AUXILIARY Scholarship Application

The Mary Ann Pease Scholarship was established in loving tribute to Mary Ann Pease – a much beloved Director of Volunteer Services at Columbus Regional for more than 20 years. During her career, Mary Ann developed the Youth Volunteer Program which has since encouraged countless young adults to choose health care careers.

This scholarship may be awarded twice a year to Piedmont Columbus Regional employees currently enrolled or accepted into an accredited school program who are furthering their clinical education to help make a positive difference in every life we touch.

Funding may be provided during both or one of the following timeframes:

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Eligibility:

1. Piedmont Columbus Regional (PCR) employees that have been employed for at least one (1) year and in good standing with no disciplinary actions and received a satisfactory evaluation in the previous year with PCR
2. Accepted into an accredited four-year, community college health sciences program or approved certification
3. Agrees to continue employment with PCR or its affiliates for a term of at least (2) years at the completion of degree or program certificate
4. Submit the following application package to the PCR Auxiliary:
 - a. Completed application
 - b. Proof of acceptance into an accredited school and an unofficial transcript
 - c. Minimum 3.0 GPA
 - d. Complete a 250-word essay
 - e. Letter of recommendation from PCR supervisor

Terms:

1. The scholarship will be used solely for the purpose of supporting the applicant's education and paid directly to the institution in the name of the recipient.
2. Scholarship(s) of up to \$1,000 may be awarded semi-annually upon completion of application package.
3. Scholarships do not rollover and employees (or recipients of prior scholarships) must apply each funding cycle.
4. If a scholarship is awarded, consideration will only be valid for continuous enrollment in a professionally accredited four-year or community college health sciences program and continuous employment at PCR. Missing a semester of school will result in the loss of a scholarship; reason for a postponement or discontinuation may be appealed to the PCR Director of Clinical Operations or Director of associated department. If the recipient wishes to re-apply at a later date.
5. The recipient must submit a copy of their transcript for the prior semester and enrollment confirmation for the upcoming semester and must include:
 - Grades received in previous semester
 - Current GPA
6. Letter of recommendation completed by immediate PCR supervisor or manager; may provide more than one.
7. Scholarship recipients may be asked to provide a report on the impact the scholarship has had on your nursing career at PCR.
