- □ Retrieve and return your required health records:
 - □ COVID (vaccinations, boosters)
 - □ Flu (Varicella, proof of most recent vaccination)
 - □ MMR (mumps, measles, rubella)
 - □ Tuberculosis (two-step skin test, proof of results)
 - Doctor-signed waiver if unvaccinated for any reason
- □ Provide recommendation forms with 2 of your references
- □ Write and return 200-word essay, "I want to volunteer at Piedmont because..."
- □ Submit all via email attachments to Volunteer Services Office: Nancy.Williams@piedmont.org and Kelsey.Kean@piedmont.org
